Pawnbrokers are reminded that LSA-R.S. 37:1800(B) of the Louisiana Pawnshop Act requires that in the event that the pawnshop is not open for business on the maturity date of a pawn transaction, the forfeiture date shall be the day immediately following the next business day the pawnshop is open after the maturity date.

During this time, licensed lenders, pawnbrokers, and mortgage brokers, lenders and originators can continue to access the online licensing system to transition and update their licensing data.
